## VILLAGE OF HOSSTON MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD OCTOBER 12, 2021

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Hosston met in regular session Tuesday, October 12, 2021, at 6:30 p.m., in the Village Hall, Hosston, LA.

Present: Mayor Kim Jaynes, Alderman Misti Banks, Alderman Henry Blunt, Alderman Tiffany Payton, Chief of Police Ramona Anders, Town Clerk Amanda Anglin

Absent: None

Also Present: Michael Anders, LeeAnne Blunt.

Mayor Jaynes called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m., at which time a quorum was verified. Opening prayer was led by Alderman Banks and all present joined in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, no opposed, motion carries.

The next item on the agenda was public comments on agenda items: There were none.

Mayor Jaynes said the Boom or Bust Byway Clean Up at the Robert L. Nance Park was successful. Letters have been sent out about the street lights. Soon that issue will be resolved.

Alderman Payton made a motion to approve the September 2021 meeting minutes, seconded by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, no opposed, motion carries.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve the August 2021 & September 2021 financial statements, second by Alderman Payton. All in favor, no opposed, motion carries.

Chief Anders recommended Michael Anders and Emmett Carter becoming uncompensated Reserve Police Officers, contingent on Mr. Anders service to Hosston not being an ethics violation. Chief Anders will be contacting the ethics board about the matter. Alderman Banks made a motion to approve Mr. Anders and Mr. Carter becoming Reserve Officers, second by Alderman Payton. All in favor, no opposed, motion carries.

Public comments were asked for, none given.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to adjourn at 6:47 p.m., seconded by Alderman Payton. All in favor, no opposed, motion carries.
