VILLAGE OF HOSSTON MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD AUGUST 16, 2022

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Hosston met in regular session Tuesday, August 16, 2022, at 6:30 p.m., in the Village Hall, Hosston, LA. Present: Mayor Kim Jaynes, Alderman Henry Blunt, Alderman Misti Banks, Alderman Tiffany Payton, Police Chief Ramona Anders, Town Clerk Amanda Anglin Absent: None Also Present: Michael Anders, LeeAnne Blunt, Bricen Prentice

Mayor Jaynes called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m., at which time a quorum was verified. Opening prayer was led by Chief Anders and all present joined in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Alderman Payton made a motion to approve the agenda, second by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

The next item on the agenda was public comments on agenda items. There were none.

Chief Anders reported she has given a few speed warnings due to the speed limit change on Rosedale. Please be aware that the speed limit is now 35mph. If you are transporting garbage in the back of a truck, make sure it does not blow out. Litter is a big problem in Hosston.

Mayor Jaynes reminded the Board about the yard sale on Saturday, September 3rd, 9:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m., along with an ice cream bash 12:00 p.m.-1:00 p.m. Jimmy Silvio will be signing the annexation papers and water agreement soon. Hosston was approved for the LA Love Outdoors grant. A pavilion will be installed between the village hall and police department, complete with a walking trail and bridge. Letters will be sent out regarding tall grass, litter, unpaid occupational licenses, and water customers sharing a water meter.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve the July 2022 meeting minutes, seconded by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Alderman Payton made a motion to approve the July 2022 financial statements, second by Alderman

Banks. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Mayor Jaynes told the Board that the water standpipe must be repaired or replaced due to a leak. She is also looking into electronic read water meters and the possibility of the water sector grant covering both issues.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve authorizing the Mayor to proceed with the procurement and selection of professional services for the purpose of assisting in the development of the Water Sector Program application/proposal and implementation of the project, if funded, second by Alderman Payton. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Alderman Payton made a motion to introduce amending Ordinance No. 4 of 2021 titled AN ORDINANCE REGARDING WATER SERVICE PROVIDED BY THE VILLAGE OF HOSSTON WATER SYSTEM, second by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried. A public hearing will be held at the September 20, 2022, meeting.

Public comments were called for. There were none.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to adjourn at 6:49 p.m., seconded by Alderman Banks. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.
