VILLAGE OF HOSSTON MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD JULY 19, 2022

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Hosston met in regular session Tuesday, July 19, 2022, at 6:30 p.m., in the Village Hall, Hosston, LA. Present: Mayor Kim Jaynes, Alderman Henry Blunt, Alderman Misti Banks, Police Chief Ramona Anders, Town Clerk Amanda Anglin Absent: Alderman Tiffany Payton Also Present: Travis Morehart, LeeAnne Blunt, Bricen Prentice

Mayor Jaynes called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m., at which time a quorum was verified. Opening prayer was led by Alderman Banks and all present joined in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve the agenda, second by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Travis Morehart from Cook & Morehart, CPAs, gave a report on the 2021 audit review. Hosston received one finding due to the previous administration failing to adopt the 2021 budget according to proper budget procedure.

Mayor Jaynes opened the Public Hearing to amend Ordinance No. 2 of 2019 AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SAFE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE MUNICIPALITY AND OTHERWISE PROVIDING WITH RESPECT THERETO. There no questions or comments from the public regarding the ordinance. Mayor Jaynes closed the hearing.

The next item on the agenda was public comments on agenda items. There were none.

Chief Anders has stepped up patrol and is keeping a check on vacant houses. She also reminded the Board that a burn ban is in effect.

Mayor Jaynes told the Board that the 4th of July celebration went well. A clean-up day is scheduled for 9:00 a.m. until noon on Saturday, July 23rd. On Saturday, September 3rd, we will have another yard sale 9:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m., along with an ice cream bash 12:00 p.m.-1:00 p.m. The water department is

implementing a system that will notify customers of important matters such as boil advisories or water leaks.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to approve the June 2022 meeting minutes, seconded by Alderman Banks. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve the June 2022 financial statements, second by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 2 of 2022 titled AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS UNDER CHAPTER 7, TO PROVIDE FOR ALCOHOL BEVERAGE CONTROL; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF SAME, second by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve amending Ordinance No. 2 of 2019 titled AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SAFE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE MUNICIPALITY AND OTHERWISE PROVIDING WITH RESPECT THERETO, reducing the speed limit on Rosedale to 35 mph from 45 mph, second by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Public comments were called for. There were none.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to adjourn at 7:10 p.m., seconded by Alderman Banks. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.
