VILLAGE OF HOSSTON MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD SEPTEMBER 20, 2022

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Hosston met in regular session Tuesday, September 20, 2022, at 6:30 p.m., in the Village Hall, Hosston, LA.

Mayor Jaynes called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m., at which time a quorum was verified. Opening prayer was led by Chief Anders and all present joined in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Jaynes introduced Bert Carson from Sustainability Partners and Chad Robinson with ETEC to present information on replacing the existing water meters. Mayor Jaynes is actively looking at this possibility because a lot of our meters are very old and not working correctly.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve the agenda, second by Alderman Payton. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Mayor Jaynes opened a public hearing for amending Ordinance No. 4 of 2021, titled: AN ORDINANCE REGARDING WATER SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE VILLAGE OF HOSSTON WATER SYSTEM. There were no public comments. Mayor Jaynes closed the hearing.

The next item on the agenda was public comments on agenda items. There were none.

Chief Anders reported she has gotten a few suspicious person calls. She has been patrolling daily.

Mayor Jaynes reported the yard sale was a success. No bids were received on the generator or tank. Jimmy Silvio signed the annexation papers and water agreement. The standpipe and storage tank will be inspected tomorrow. September 24th will be another clean-up day. October 22nd Hosston will be hosting a fall festival with food and games for kids. Hosston needs to purchase a truck suitable for hauling the lawnmower and such.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to approve the August 2022 meeting minutes, seconded by Alderman Payton. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve the August 2022 financial statements, second by Alderman Payton. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Alderman Banks made a motion to amend Ordinance No. 4 of 2021 titled AN ORDINANCE REGARDING WATER SERVICE PROVIDED BY THE VILLAGE OF HOSSTON WATER SYSTEM, second by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Alderman Payton made a motion to introduce Ordinance No. 8 of 2019 Title: AN ORDINANCE FOR WATER INCREASE FOR ALL WATER CUSTOMERS, second by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried. A public hearing will be held at the October 18, 2022, meeting.

Public comments were called for. There were none.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to adjourn at 7:28 p.m., seconded by Alderman Banks. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.
