VILLAGE OF HOSSTON MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD APRIL 18, 2023

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Hosston met in regular session Tuesday, April 18, 2023, at 6:30 p.m., in the Village Hall, Hosston, LA.

Present: Mayor Kim Jaynes, Alderman Henry Blunt, Alderman Misti Banks, Alderman Larry Pappan, Police Chief Ramona Anders, Town Clerk Amanda Anglin

Mayor Jaynes called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m., at which time a quorum was verified. Opening prayer was led by Mayor Jaynes and all present joined in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve the agenda, second by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

There were no public comments on agenda items.

Chief Anders had no report.

Mayor Jaynes reported Sustainability Partners has declined to pursue our water meter project. The Easter egg hunt was a success. An organization has contacted town hall about painting a mural celebrating our town heritage in Hosston. We also have been awarded a sign depicting five things Hosston is known for. The new trash receptacles are being installed around town. April 22nd will be a clean-up day. Mayor Jaynes will be attending Municipal Day in Baton Rouge next week. Senator Tarver and Caddo Commissioner Hopkins are trying to obtain some funding to help repair the standpipe.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to approve the March 21, 2023, meeting minutes, seconded by Alderman Pappan. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve the March 2023 financial statements, second by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Mayor Jaynes presented proposals from RGD Architecture for \$4,500.00 and Wynne Construction, LLC for \$60,500.00 for the library grant remodel. Alderman Pappan made a motion to accept both proposals, second by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Chief Anders made a recommendation to the Board that Hosston start issuing permits allowing residents to ride four-wheelers, side-by-sides, and golf carts on designated residential streets. Mayor Jaynes told the Board that our city attorney, Doug Dominick, had advised against the matter because it could go against state law. Alderman Blunt made a motion to table the matter to allow time for more research, second by Alderman Pappan. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Public comments were called for. There were none.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to adjourn at 6:51 p.m., seconded by Alderman Banks. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.
