VILLAGE OF HOSSTON MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD MAY 16, 2023

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Hosston met in regular session Tuesday, May 16, 2023, at 6:30 p.m., in the Village Hall, Hosston, LA.

Present: Mayor Kim Jaynes, Alderman Henry Blunt, Alderman Misti Banks, Alderman Larry Pappan, Police Chief Ramona Anders, Town Clerk Amanda Anglin

Mayor Jaynes called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m., at which time a quorum was verified. Opening prayer was led by Alderman Banks and all present joined in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Jaynes opened a public hearing for Ordinance No. 2 of 2023 Title: ORDINANCE ANNEXING APPROXIMATELY 8.5 ACRES OF LAND INTO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF HOSSTON, CADDO PARISH, LOUISIANA. No public comments or questions on the ordinance. Mayor Jaynes closed the hearing.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to approve the agenda, second by Alderman Pappan. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

There were no public comments on agenda items.

Chief Anders had no report.

Mayor Jaynes reported that issues at the library led to having the septic tank cleaned out, so she had the tank at town hall checked. It was full as well and had to be emptied. The field lines at the library need to be replaced and will cost \$2,600.00. We will be having a community yard sale on June 10th at town hall from 9am – 1pm. If you would like to donate items to be sold, please bring them to town hall. No one has shown any interest in helping with a July 4th event. If no one wants to help, we will not have one. Don't forget about the community wide luncheon at The Old Church House on the third Wednesday of the month.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve the April 4, 2023, special session meeting minutes and the

April 18, 2023, regular session meeting minutes, seconded by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve the April 2023 financial statements, second by Alderman Pappan. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 2 of 2023 Title: ORDINANCE ANNEXING APPROXIMATELY 8.5 ACRES OF LAND INTO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF HOSSTON, CADDO PARISH, LOUISIANA, second by Alderman Pappan. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Mayor Jaynes explained to the Board only one bid was submitted for the walking trail project, and it was unresponsive, so we need to advertise for bids again. Alderman Banks made a motion to readvertise for bids on the walking trail and pavilion project, second by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Public comments were called for. There were none.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to adjourn at 6:43 p.m., seconded by Alderman Banks. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.
