VILLAGE OF HOSSTON MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD AUGUST 20, 2024

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Hosston met in regular session Tuesday, August 20, 2024, at 6:30 pm, in the Village Hall, Hosston, LA.

Present: Mayor Kim Jaynes, Alderman Misti Banks, Alderman Henry Blunt, Alderman Vicki Carter, and Chief Ramona Anders.

Mayor Jaynes called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm, at which time a quorum was verified. Opening prayer was led by Alderman Carter and all present joined in the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no public comments on agenda items.

Chief Anders reported that she attended a CSO class where she received useful information and resources that would be beneficial. She reported a few incidents that had recently occurred around town and reminds people to give her a call if they see anything suspicious or out of the ordinary.

Mayor Jaynes informed the board that some work had been done to the police station with new paint and new upgrades on utilities. She also stated that work is to be done on the porch and ramp as well. She announced that Haughton donated one of their old fire trucks to Hosston. New tires were purchased for the donated truck and a decal will soon be placed on the side. She informed the board that the town had also purchased a new Ford truck with the funds received from the LGAP grant. She updated the board about the beautification grant, to which Hosston did not receive.

Alderman Carter made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular session meeting on July 23, 2024, seconded by Alderman Banks. All in favor, motion carried.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve the financials for July 2024, seconded by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, motion carried.

There was no new business to discuss on the agenda.

Public Comments: Jessie Colston introduced himself and his wife. He stated that he is running for Police Chief and gave a brief explanation of his reason why and his experience in the field.
