VILLAGE OF HOSSTON MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD JUNE 16, 2026

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Hosston met in regular session Tuesday, June 16, 2026, at 6:30pm, in the Village Hall, Hosston, LA.

Present: Mayor Kim Jaynes, Alderman Crystal Carnley, Alderman Henry Blunt, Alderman Misti Banks, Chief Jessie Colston, and Hayden Linn, Town Clerk.

Mayor Jaynes called the meeting to order at 6:30pm, at which time a quorum was verified. Opening prayer was led by Chief Colston and all present joined in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, motion carried.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to approve the minutes for the May 19, 2026, regular session meeting, seconded by Alderman Banks. All in favor, motion carried.

Alderman Carnley made a motion to approve the financials for May 2026, seconded by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, motion carried.

Mayor Jaynes addressed the board and informed them that word was going around that she, as well as the board, was not conducting the meetings correctly because the minutes were not being read aloud. Mayor Jaynes stated that she asks in advance if they would like to hear the minutes to which the board declines. The alderman agreed with this statement. She also asked the board if the minutes were provided ahead of time in their packets, to which they agreed they were. She also stated that the minutes are posted in the official journal, as well as the town website. The alderman all agreed that the minutes were easily accessible for them, as well as the public.

Mayor Jaynes informed the board that the 2010 Dodge Charger used for the Police Department had been sold at auction and a check was received in the amount \$2,272.50.

The new water meters are scheduled to arrive in July and the amending of Ordinance No. 4 of 2021 will be

addressed at the next town meeting.

Mayor Jaynes was excited to tell the board that the town has received two grants from Senator Jenkins. One is for the Black Bayou Festival in the amount of \$10,000.00 and the other is the Capital Outlay Grant for the Hosston Mira Water system in the amount of \$803,058.00.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to adjourn at 6:48pm, seconded by Alderman Carnley. All in favor, motion carried.
