VILLAGE OF HOSSTON MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD APRIL 15, 2025

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Hosston met in regular session Tuesday, April 15, 2025, at 6:30 pm, in the Village Hall, Hosston, LA.

Present: Mayor Kim Jaynes, Alderman Henry Blunt, Alderman Crystal Carnley, Alderman Misti Banks, Chief Jessie Colston, and Hayden Linn, Town Clerk.

Mayor Jaynes called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm, at which time a quorum was verified. Opening prayer was led by Alderman Banks and all present joined in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Alderman Blunt. All in favor motion carried.

There were no public comments on the agenda items.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to approve the minutes for the March 18, 2025 regular session meeting, seconded by Alderman Carnley. All in favor, motion carried.

Alderman Banks made a motion to approve the financials for March 2025, seconded by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, motion carried.

Mrs. McInnis also brought it to the mayor's attention that Lawrason was misspelled in the March 18, 2025 regular session meeting to which the mayor replied that it would be corrected.
