## VILLAGE OF HOSSTON MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD APRIL 21, 2026

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Hosston met in regular session Tuesday, April 21, 2026, at 6:30pm, in the Village Hall, Hosston, LA.

Present: Mayor Kim Jaynes, Alderman Crystal Carnley, Alderman Henry Blunt, Alderman Misti Banks, Chief Jessie Colston, and Hayden Linn, Town Clerk.

Mayor Jaynes called the meeting to order at 6:30pm, at which time a quorum was verified. Opening prayer was led by Chief Colston and all present joined in the Pledge of Allegiance.

A public hearing was opened at 6:32pm for **Ordinance No. 2 of 2026 (Amended)** TITLE: AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF 2025 AN ORDINANCE TO APPOINT AND FIX THE SALARY FOR THE TOWN CLERK OF THE VILLAGE OF HOSSTON. There were no questions or comments. The public hearing was closed at 6:32pm.

Alderman Banks made a motion to amend the agenda to add donating wells #2 and #3 back to the landowners, seconded by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, motion carried.

A public hearing was opened at 6:33pm to amend the agenda to add donating wells #2 and #3 back to the landowners. There were no questions or comments. The public hearing was closed at 6:33pm.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to approve the minutes for the March 17, 2026, regular session meeting, seconded by Alderman Carnley. All in favor, motion carried.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to approve the financials for March 2026, seconded by Alderman Banks. All in favor, motion carried.

Alderman Banks made a motion to adopt **Ordinance No. 2 of 2026 (Amended)** TITLE: AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF 2025 AN ORDINANCE TO APPOINT AND FIX THE SALARY FOR THE TOWN CLERK OF THE VILLAGE OF HOSSTON, seconded by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, motion carried.

A discussion was held on approving the white charger used for the police department for surplus or to enter it into the Lawler Auction. The Board agreed to have the charger put in the auction.

Alderman Carnley made a motion to allow Chief Colston to enter the charger into the auction of his choice that best suited the vehicle, seconded by Alderman Banks. All in favor, motion carried.

A discussion was held on wells #2 and #3. The third well up for debate has yet to be located.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to donate the wells #2 and #3 back to the landowners, seconded by Alderman Carnley. All in favor, motion carried.

Tracey Laing with the Hosston Library informed the Board of the Story Walk that will take place around the walking path. It will be held May 4- May 29 and is a way to incorporate families into learning and healthy wellness in the community. Another Story Walk will likely be held in October.

Alderman Carnley made a motion to adjourn at 6:58pm, seconded by Alderman Banks. All in favor, motion carried.
