- 1. Any disputes arising under the terms and conditions of this contest will be governed by Newberry township.
- 2. All contestants must be over the age of 11 years old, and any child under the age of 18 MUST have the permission of their parents to enter the contest.
- 3. No Copyright Infringement: All entries must contain copyright-free art or art released for entrant's and public use. No unauthorized use of any copyright images, text, or other material will be accepted.
- 4. You must be the creator of the art that you submit to the competition. Your art must be your own original concept and not a copy of anyone else's copyrighted material. (If your image infringes upon another's copyright it will be disqualified.) Upon submitting your work to this competition, you are solely responsible for any infringement on copyrighted materials.
- 5. By entering this art competition, you are granting us a non-exclusive perpetual license to reproduce images of your artwork on our website, in our print media, newsletters, exhibits, website, print collateral, display images, and/or any additional event promotional materials, in the marketing of future art competitions to the general public.
- 6. Content should be appropriate for public use. (If it wouldn't be acceptable for a Times Square billboard, it wont be acceptable here.)
- 7. Media allowed includes: Pen, pencil, markers, paints, charcoal, graphic media, and paper. (No canvas art)
- 8. No artwork will be accepted past the posted deadline, September 30th, 2022.
