RESOLUTION NO. 2024-38

A RESOLUTION **OF** THE **BOARD OF** SUPERVISORS OF NEWBERRY TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY, TO CREATE THE A DRIVER/OPERATOR PROGRAM TO INCREASE THE RELIABILITY OF FIRE DEPARTMENT APPARATUS RESPONDING TO EMERGENCY CALLS IN A TIMELY MANNER TO PROVIDE FIRE SUPPRESSION AND RESCUE SERVICES TO THE **TOWNSIHP** AND SURROUNDING COMMUNITIES.

WHEREAS, Newberry Township ("Township") is a second class township, governed by the Second Class Township Code (the "Code"), which provides in § 1506 (53 P.S. § 66506) that the Township has authority to make and adopt regulations for the proper management, care, and control of the township and the maintenance of peace, good government, health, and welfare of the Township and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, under § 1801 of the Code (53 P.S. § 66801), the Township has authority to provide for fire protection within the Township, including making regulations within the Township or within such limits, as may be deemed proper, relative to the cause and management of fires and the prevention thereof; and

WHEREAS, under § 1553 of the Code (53 P.S. § 66553), the Township is authorized to provide for the fire and emergency medical services within the Township, including the operation and maintenance of motor vehicles for the purpose of conveying the sick and injured persons of the Township and the provision of administrative assistance for those services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors believes it to be in the best interests of the maintenance of peace, good government, health, and welfare of the Township and its citizens to increase the reliability of fire department apparatus responding to emergency calls in a timely manner to provide fire suppression and rescue services to the Township and surrounding communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township resolves as follows:

Section 1. The Township desires to to establish the Professional Driver/Operator program Professional Driver/Operator Program ("Driver Program") to increase the reliability of fire department apparatus responding to emergency calls in a timely manner to provide fire suppression and rescue services to the Township and surrounding communities.

Section 2. The Driver Program is also established to assist volunteer fire departments which have primary fire district coverage in the Township with daily tasks such as equipment inspection and maintenance as well as fire prevention education to local schools.

Section 3. The Township desires to executed the Memorandum of Understanding, as attached hereto as Exhibit A, to allow for the establishment of the Driver Program.

Section 4. All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
