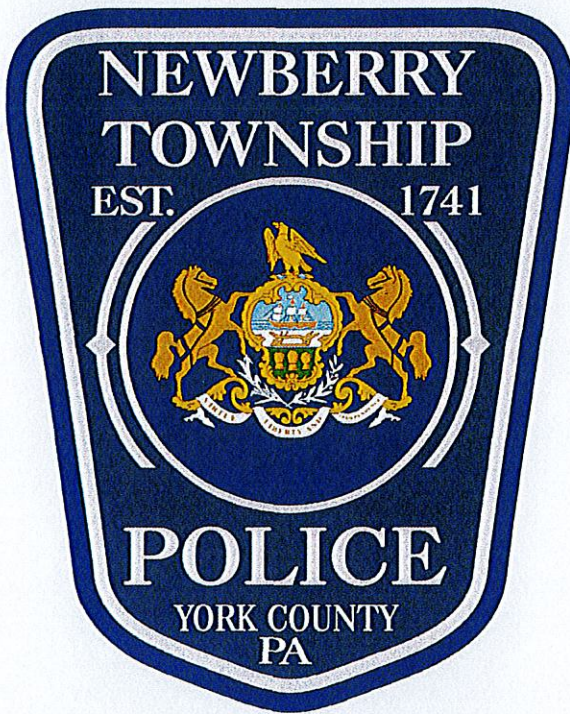

Supervisors and Staff,

The department handled 1416 calls for the month of May 2026. Listing calls by criteria: 3 Aggravated Assaults, 1 Burglary, 7 Thefts, 5 Drug Offenses, 3 DUI's, 10 Simple Assaults, and 11 all other offenses. Additionally, officers responded to and investigated 1376 other calls for service including 27 Domestic related incidents and 33 traffic accidents. They issued 112 traffic citations, 201 warnings, issued 14 non-traffic citations and made 25 misdemeanor/felony criminal arrests.

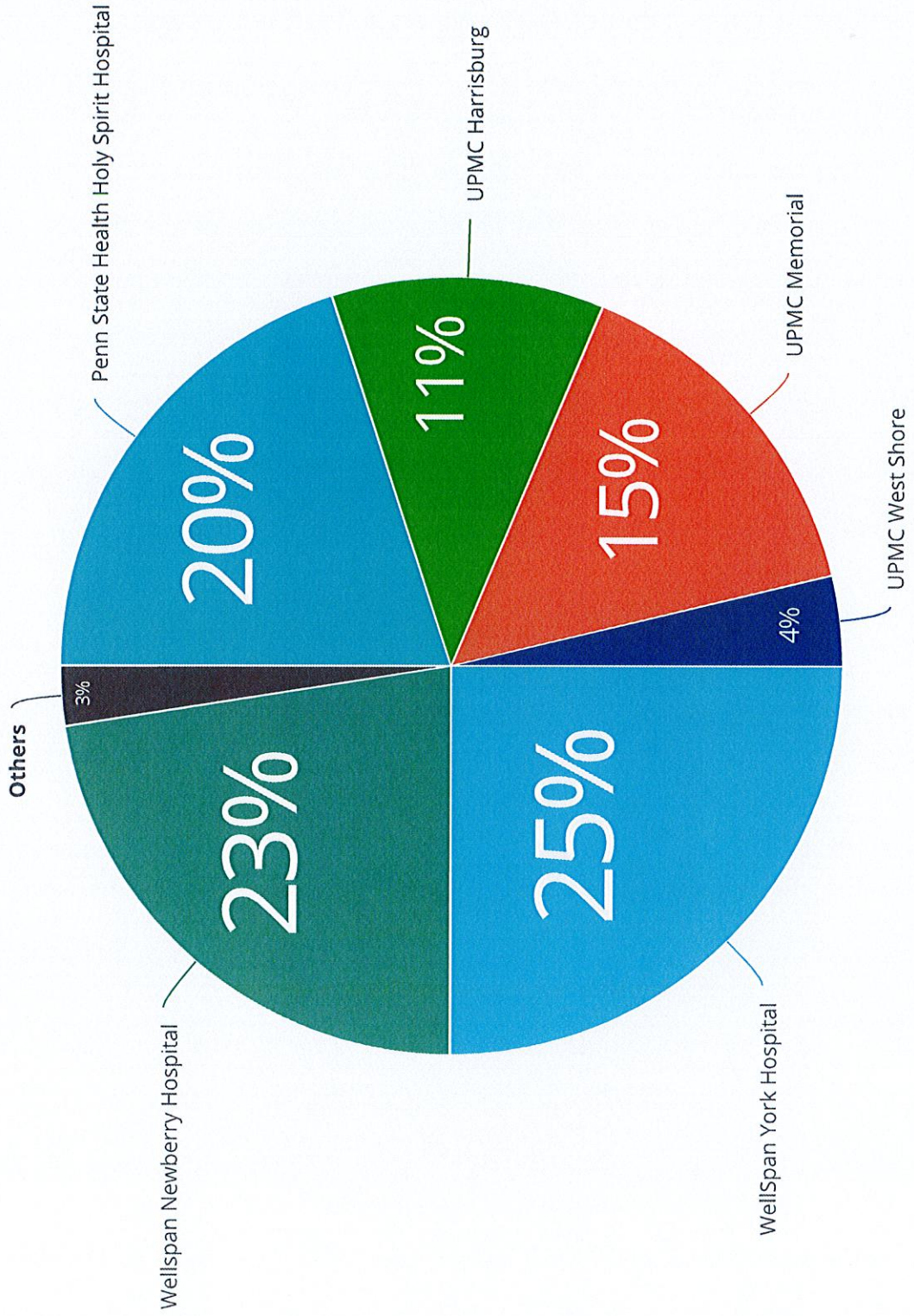

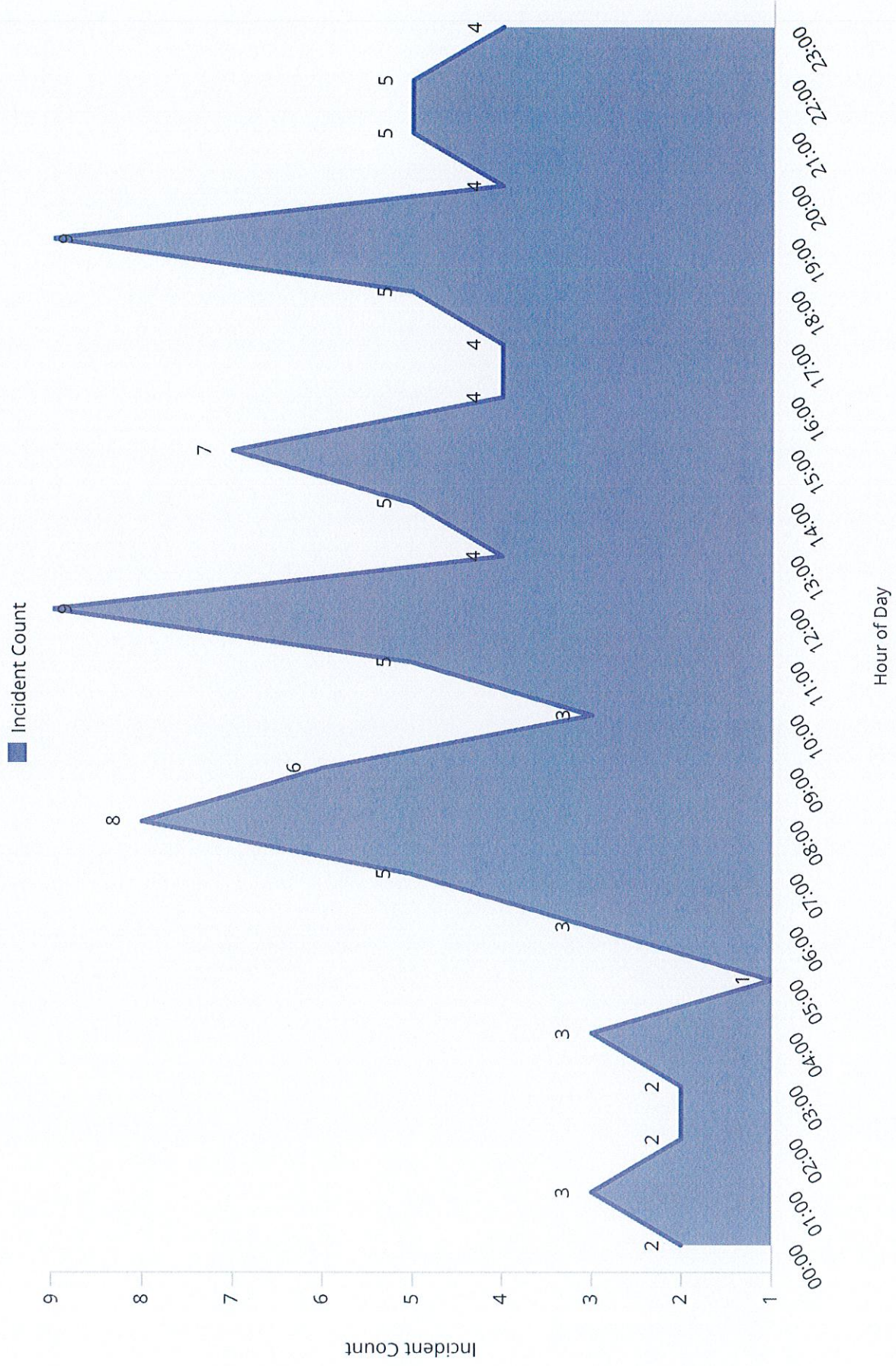

Station 27 – York Haven Fire Company

May 2026 Monthly Report

During the month of May 2026, Station 27 handled a total of 26 calls for service, with 21 incidents occurring within Newberry Township and an additional 5 mutual aid responses outside the township. Primary incidents included fire police details, medical assists, motor vehicle accidents, structure fires, fire alarms, carbon monoxide alarms, wires down, and public safety assists.

Station 27 remained active throughout the month while continuing emergency response operations, training efforts, and community support activities.

Station 28 – Goldsboro Fire Company

May 2026 Monthly Report

During the month of May 2026, Station 28 handled a total of 26 calls for service, with 24 incidents occurring within Newberry Township and 2 mutual aid responses outside the township. Incidents included brush fires, motor vehicle accidents, motor vehicle accidents with entrapment, fire police operations, alarms, carbon monoxide alarms, wires down, disabled vehicles, medical assists, and public safety assists.

Station 28 members contributed approximately 295 total man-hours during the month, including:

- 205 hours dedicated to emergency response activities
- 40 hours of training
- 50 hours supporting fundraising and department operations

Station 28 continues to remain active in emergency response, training, and community support throughout the township.

Station 31 – Newberry Township Fire Department

May 2026 Monthly Report

During the month of May 2026, Station 31 handled a total of 45 calls for service, including 35 incidents within Newberry Township and 10 mutual aid responses outside the township. The department responded to a wide variety of emergencies including motor vehicle accidents, motor vehicle accidents with entrapment, structure fires, medical assists, landing zones, public service calls, wires/pole fires, fire police details, and a water rescue incident.

Station 31 personnel contributed approximately 451 total man-hours throughout the month, including:

- 226 hours dedicated to emergency response operations
- 105 hours of training
- 120 hours supporting fundraising and community events

The department remained highly active throughout May while continuing training initiatives and maintaining operational readiness for both local and mutual aid responses.
