



Supervisors and Staff,

The department handled 1146 calls for the month of August 2025. Listing calls by criteria: 1 Agg Assault, 1 Burglary, 11 Thefts, 7 Drug Offenses, 4 DUI's, 8 Simple Assaults, 1 Sexual Assault, 3 Harassments, and 16 all other offenses. Additionally, officers responded to and investigated 1094 other calls for service including 15 Domestic related incidents and 30 traffic accidents. They issued 88 traffic citations, 140 warnings, issued 16 non-traffic citations and made 37 misdemeanor/felony criminal arrests.

- UV Upgrade Part II Permit Re-submitted at the end June to DEP. Waiting on Permit and completing Construction Drawings Currently 95% Complete.
- Meeting with Public was held on 6/26/25 to review the Cly Road Project.
- Process Solutions has provided a proposal to provide the UV equipment through Costars. Waiting on the permit from DEP to sign the pre-purchase agreement for the equipment based on the board approval of the purchase at the June Board meeting. Currently the equipment is 22 weeks out.
