**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF
SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
NEWBERRY PROVIDING FOR SUPPLEMENTAL
APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE 2024 BUDGET**

WHEREAS, Newberry Township (“Township”) is a second class township duly organized and existing under the Second Class Township Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township adopted a budget for the calendar year 2024 on December 12, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code Article XXXII, Section 3202(e) authorizes the Supervisors to, by Resolution, make supplemental appropriations for any lawful purpose from any funds on hand or estimated to be received within the fiscal year not otherwise appropriated; and

WHEREAS, the Township has the funds available to make the supplemental expenditures in its Highway Capital Reserve Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Newberry Township, to make the following supplemental appropriations for the 2024 budget from the Highway Capital Reserve Fund of the Township:


SECTION 1. An appropriation for the purchase of a replacement dog (K-9) for the Newberry Township Police Department, which was the result of insurance proceeds received by the Township.


