**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NEWBERRY PROVIDING  
FOR APPROVAL TO INVEST MONEY MARKET  
FUNDS WITH TRADITIONS BANK IN A TREASURY  
LADDER**

**WHEREAS**, Newberry Township ("Township") is a second class township duly organized and existing under the Second Class Township Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township currently has General Fund related funds currently invested in a money market account with Traditions Bank; and

**WHEREAS**, the Second Class Township Code Article XXXII, Section 3204 authorizes the Supervisors to invest Township funds in United States Treasury Bills; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township now desires to move up to \$1Million of the balance of the General Funds now held in a Money Market Account into a Treasury Ladder with laddered dates for maturity with Traditions Bank.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of Newberry Township, to do the following:

**SECTION 1.** Move up to \$1Million of the balance of the General Fund currently in a money market account to a Treasury Ladder with laddered dates for maturity with Traditions Bank


**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately.
