**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NEWBERRY PROVIDING FOR SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE 2023 BUDGET**

---

**WHEREAS**, Newberry Township (“Township”) is a second class township duly organized and existing under the Second Class Township Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of the Township adopted a budget for the calendar year 2023 on December 13, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the Second Class Township Code Article XXXII, Section 3202(e) authorizes the Supervisors to, by Resolution, make supplemental appropriations for any lawful purpose from any funds on hand or estimated to be received within the fiscal year not otherwise appropriated; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has the funds available to make the supplemental expenditures in its General Fund.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of Newberry Township, to make the following supplemental appropriations for the 2023 budget from the General Fund of the Township:

**SECTION 1.** An appropriation for the purchase of (2) 4500 Chevy and (1) 5500 Chevy trucks with upfit for a total of \$329,742.09.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately.
