

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-11

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO THE
PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (MAP)
NEWBERRY TOWNSHIP
YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

WHEREAS, Newberry Township intends to undertake a project to develop and adopt a Comprehensive Plan update to guide future growth, land use, infrastructure coordination, and implementation strategies within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) makes available grants-in-aid for such projects through the Municipal Assistance Program (MAP); and

WHEREAS, the total anticipated project cost is One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000); and

WHEREAS, MAP funding may provide up to fifty percent (50%) of eligible project costs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Newberry Township, York County, Pennsylvania, that the Township hereby authorizes submission of an application to the Pennsylvania Municipal Assistance Program for funding in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors hereby commits municipal resources in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) as the required local match for said project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Manager is authorized to execute all documents necessary to submit the application and administer the grant, if awarded.
