




Destination Summary by Scene Zone of Newberry Twp

Supervisors and Staff,

The department handled 1016 calls for the month of January 2026. Listing calls by criteria: 1 Aggravated Assault, 9 Thefts, 1 Motor Vehicle Theft, 6 Drug Offenses, 3 DUI's, 3 Simple Assaults, 2 Harassments, and 14 all other offenses. Additionally, officers responded to and investigated 977 other calls for service including 20 Domestic related incidents and 25 traffic accidents. They issued 62 traffic citations, 119 warnings, issued 4 non-traffic citations and made 15 misdemeanor/felony criminal arrests.



Grants & Funding

- Continuing coordination with Tetra Tech to complete final MESB RACP close-out documentation for submission to the Office of the Budget.
- Monitoring status of previously submitted LSA applications for the dump truck, plow, and culvert projects.
- Beginning implementation planning steps for awarded projects, including the Cly Road Sewer Extension and park improvement grants.

Personnel

- Sewer Department employees continue training and operational onboarding.
- Recruitment efforts remain underway to fill one remaining Sewer Department position.

2026 Budget

- Departments are operating under the adopted 2026 Budget.
- Ongoing monitoring of expenditures and revenue projections to ensure alignment with budgeted expectations.

Administration

- 2026 meeting schedule is active and underway.
- Continuing review of data center development trends in neighboring municipalities in preparation for discussion with the Board regarding potential ordinance considerations.

IT & Infrastructure

- Fiber optic service is fully operational and performing well.
- All Township PCs have been updated to Windows 11; upgrades are complete with no reported issues.
- Exploring pricing options to upgrade interior lighting in the Administration Building to LED fixtures for improved efficiency and long-term cost savings.

Comprehensive Plan

- Steering Committee recommendations are being prepared for Board consideration.

Sewer & DEP

- Waste Management billing discrepancy has been fully resolved.
- Sewer piping beneath the Administration Building and former Police Building has been identified as deteriorating and will require planning for replacement within the next several years as part of long-term capital improvement planning.

Fire & Emergency Services

- Coordinating scheduling with Newberry Township Fire Department and WellSpan regarding facility use and ongoing collaboration.

Facilities & Operations

- Winter operations continue to be managed effectively by Township staff and contracted services.
- Equipment inspections and maintenance schedules remain ongoing to ensure operational readiness.

PLANNING COMMISSION ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2025

According to the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Commission (PMPC), a governing body of a municipality shall have the power to create or abolish, by ordinance, a Planning Commission or Planning Department, or both.

The Planning Commission is guided by the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance (SALDO), Zoning Ordinance, and Stormwater Management Ordinance when an Applicant submits a land development plan. All the above ordinances are available online.

MEMBERS

The Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code (PA MPC) states that the Planning Commission shall have between three to nine members.

There are currently seven members.

The Chairman and Secretary are elected to a one-year term by the members at the Reorganization Meeting in January.

The PA MPC also states that members shall be a resident of the municipality and are appointed by the appointing authority of the municipality which is the Board of Supervisors.

The Board of Supervisors appoints each member for a term of four years. If a vacancy occurs, the Chairman shall notify the appointing authority, which will appoint a successor to serve for the remainder of the term.

The Planning Commission members are Chairman - David Parsons, Vice Chairwoman - Toni Sharp and Secretary - James Alexander.

Members - Dale Jackson, Jeffrey Holland and David Kirkpatrick whose terms ended.

Members appointed during the year were Brian Rehbein, Jason Christine, Matt Musser and Erik Shingle.

Members serving for several months were Tyler Yost, Ed Ostrander and Connie Flasher.

Bill Rudy - Engineer, Tom Wymard - Attorney and Donna Donald - Codes and Zoning Officer also attended the meetings.

POWERS AND DUTIES

The PA PMC, Section 209.1, references the powers and duties of the Planning Agency.

These include making recommendations to the governing body concerning the adoption or an amendment of an official map, preparing and presenting to the governing body of the municipality a zoning ordinance. Makes recommendations to the governing body on proposed amendments to it as set forth in the Act.

Advises on subdivisions, land development, proposed residential development and other duties as listed

in the PA MPC.

The Planning Commission makes recommendations to the Board of Supervisors which renders the final decision.

Subdivision plans are submitted to the Planning Commission at their meetings by an applicant or its representative.

Also present may be an engineer, traffic engineer, attorney, surveyor and members of the public. The Planning Commission asks questions and hears comments in order to form a recommendation to present to the Board of Supervisors.

TRAINING

A knowledgeable and interested Planning Commission is important to the future development of Newberry Township and training is essential to become a more knowledgeable Planning Commission member.

Several of our members have actively participated in several training classes held at the York County Planning Commission, Springettsbury.

Training classes included the PA Municipalities Planning Code, The Role of the Planning Commission, Community Planning, A review of Subdivision and Land Development, Zoning, Zoning Administration and Duties of a Planning Commission.
