RESOLUTION NO. 2026-19

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF A TOWNSHIP-OWNED
ADMINISTRATIVE VEHICLE TO NEWBERRY TOWNSHIP FIRE COMPANY, STATION 31**

WHEREAS, Newberry Township (the "Township") is a township of the second class governed by the Second Class Township Code; and

WHEREAS, the Township owns the administrative motor vehicle described in Exhibit A to this Resolution (the "Vehicle"); and

WHEREAS, the Township previously provided the Vehicle for use in connection with the Paid Fire Driver Program while the paid fire drivers were Township employees; and

WHEREAS, the paid fire drivers are transitioning to employment by Newberry Township Fire Company, Station 31 (the "Fire Company"); and

WHEREAS, the Vehicle will continue to be used by the Fire Company for official fire-protection, emergency-response, administrative, and other public-safety purposes serving Newberry Township; and

WHEREAS, Sections 1502 and 1504 of the Second Class Township Code authorize the Board of Supervisors to approve the conveyance or disposition of Township personal property when the Board determines the transfer to be in the best interest of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the bidding and advertising requirements otherwise applicable to the sale of Township personal property do not apply to a sale or lease of personal property to a volunteer fire company; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors finds that transferring the Vehicle to the Fire Company for nominal consideration and continued public-safety use is in the best interest of the Township and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Newberry Township, York County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. Transfer Authorized. The Board of Supervisors authorizes the sale and transfer of the Vehicle described in Exhibit A to Newberry Township Fire Company, Station 31, for One Dollar (\$1.00) and the Fire Company's continued use of the Vehicle for official fire-protection, emergency-response, administrative, and public-safety purposes.

Section 2. Agreement Approved. The Vehicle Transfer Agreement and Bill of Sale between the Township and the Fire Company is approved in substantially the form presented to the Board, subject to any nonmaterial revisions approved by the Township Solicitor.

Section 3. Condition of Transfer. The Vehicle shall be transferred AS IS, WHERE IS, without any express or implied warranty. The Fire Company shall accept responsibility for the Vehicle upon completion of the title transfer, including insurance, registration, maintenance, repairs, fuel, operation, and all other ownership expenses. The Township registration plate shall be removed before delivery and is not included in the transfer.

Section 4. Completion of Title Transfer. The transfer shall become effective upon execution of the Vehicle Transfer Agreement and Bill of Sale, payment of One Dollar (\$1.00), proof of insurance in the Fire Company's name, and completion of the certificate-of-title transfer through an authorized PennDOT agent or notary.

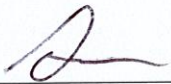
Section 5. Authorized Officials. The Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, Township Secretary, Township Manager, and other appropriate Township officials are authorized to execute the agreement, assign the certificate of title, sign any PennDOT or related documents, and take all actions reasonably necessary to complete the transfer.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

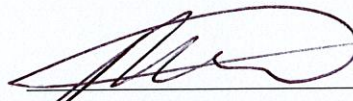

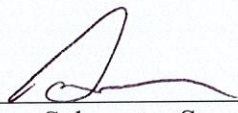
Transfer Price: One Dollar (\$1.00) and continued official fire-protection and public-safety use.
