AUTHORIZE OFFICIAL RESOLUTION 2025-29

Be it RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Newberry Township, York County, hereby requests a Category 4 Facilities Local Share Assessment grant in an amount up to \$425,000 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority.

The purpose of the grant request is to support municipal public works operations through the purchase of:

One (1) street sweeper at an estimated cost of \$415,000 (with contingency included for final procurement); and

Twelve (12) GPS-enabled dash cameras for the municipal fleet at an estimated cost of \$350 each (with contingency included).

This project will strengthen the Township's ability to meet MS4 stormwater compliance requirements, improve public works efficiency, and enhance accountability and safety in municipal fleet operations.

Be it **FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Applicant does hereby designate Aaron Schwartz, Township Manager/Secretary and Dave Kirkpatrick, Chairman, Board of Supervisors as the official(s) to execute all documents and agreements between the Newberry Township and the Commonwealth Financing Authority to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.


