## Please read the following before submitting the scholarship application.

Women Professionals in Government (WPG) scholarship candidates must be a female (including all cisgender

or transgender women) resident of the Greater Houston area, a student in good standing at an accredited university/college in the Greater Houston area, and currently pursuing studies for a career in public service. Undergraduate applicants must have completed at least 30 undergraduate hours and graduate students must have completed at least 12 graduate hours. Applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student.

This WPG scholarship application, a copy of an academic transcript, letter of recommendation from a college faculty member, employer or professional contact and the essay response must be received by no later than November 15, 2022. Please complete the application form, putting N/A in any spaces that do not apply.

WPG scholarship recipients <u>must</u> be able to attend the WPG Fall Scholarship Luncheon to be held on **December 1**, **2022** to receive their scholarships and a one-year membership to WPG for the first place finisher.

The essay response will consist of a maximum of 500 words to the following questions:

- What is your interest in pursuing a carer in public service, and how will your current educational endeavors assist your career path?
- Why do you need this scholarship, and what challenges have you faced in achieving your educational and/or professional goals?
