Undergraduate applicants must have completed at least 30 undergraduate hours and graduate students must have completed at least 12 graduate hours. Applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student. This WPG scholarship application, a copy of an academic transcript, a letter of recommendation from a college faculty member, employer or professional contact, and the essay response must be received by no later than **April 30, 2024**. Please complete the application form, putting N/A in any spaces that do not apply.WPG scholarship recipients must be able to attend the WPG May Scholarship Luncheon to be held on May 2, 2024, to

receive their scholarships and a one-year membership to WPG for the first-place finisher. The essay response will consist of a maximum of 500 words to the following questions:
