CLASS/DIVISION DESCRIPTIONS:

AHJA Members may have additional cross-entry restrictions. Refer to the 2021-2022 AHJA Rule Book for specifications on AHJA Medal classes.

Warmup Classes are unjudged.

Leadline/Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 10 years and younger. Riders may be accompanied in the ring by adults with or without a lead. Note: May cross-enter in Walk Trot divisions.

Mini Crossrail Equitation: Fences 9"; Open to novice riders. Trotting not penalized. Riders may not cross-enter into any classes with fences higher than 12".

Crossrail: Fences 12"; Riders may not cross enter into any classes with fences higher than 24". Trotting allowed.

Future Hunter/Rider: Fences 18"; riders may not cross-enter into any classes with fences higher than 2'. No oxers.

Mini, Youth, & Silver Stirrup

Mini Stirrup: 11 y/o & under; Young: ages 12-17; Silver: 18 & over. Fences 2'; riders may not cross-enter into any classes higher than 2'3". No oxers. All three divisions may be combined for points.

Pre-Children's/Adult: Fences 2'3"; riders may not cross-enter into any classes with fences higher than 2'6".

Children's/Adult: Fences 2'6"; riders may not cross-enter into any classes with fences higher than 2'9".

Junior/Adult: Fences 2'9". No cross-entry restrictions.

Pony Hunter: Fences 2'; no oxers. Open to all ages (non-pros). May be split Juniors & Adults if entries warrant.

NEW Money Class - Rider Over Obstacles: A classic Australian jumper class to be judged on control, etiquette, safety, course riding, riding position and paces all while having to complete the course within a preset time. **\$250 Prize Money** (\$40 entry fee). Minimum of 8 entries to run class; classes may be combined based on entries. Class is open to both hunters and jumpers that are entered in a minimum of 3 other classes.

- Under 18 yrs.: Over fences up to 2'3"
- Under 18 yrs.: Over fences up to 2'6"
- 18+: Over fences up to 2'9"

INFO & PRIZES

Show management reserves the right to refuse any entries at its sole discretion.

Show management may add or delete classes.

Show management may combine classes/divisions.

Attire & Equipment: Riding boots with a heel and an ASTM-approved riding helmet are mandatory for riders. USEF rules will be followed for horse equipment. Exception: wraps or boots are allowed. Martingales are prohibited in non-jumping and hunter hack classes.

Riders may share a horse in the same Hunter/Eq classes. Each horse/rider combo has a separate number. Points follow the number.

Professionals may be judged in an Open or Schooling class and all Jumper classes. They may enter other classes but will not be judged.

AGES: All age restrictions are as at Dec 1, 2012.

CSHS Awards & Prizes: Ribbons awarded 1st - 6th place. Championship and Reserve Championship ribbons are awarded for each division. Additional prizes awarded for 1st Place and Championships.

For **Championships** to be awarded, there must be a minimum of 3 entries per class, and exhibitor must have entered in all classes in the division. Each CSHS Hunter and/or Equitation division is 3 or 5 classes.

Hunter & Jumper division Championships & Reserve Championships to be awarded.

Notable Coconino Horse Stable Area Rules:

1. Stall and camping fees must be paid to Copper State Horse Shows
2. All litter and trash must be placed in trash receptacles.
3. Manure must be placed in designated collection areas.
4. Trailers and vehicles must be parked a minimum of 20 feet from all barns.
5. No stalls shall be used for any purpose other than for housing horses, livestock, tack or feed.
6. Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
7. Use of electricity is limited to the horse washing station. Patrons may not plug into outlets in the barn area.
8. Failure to follow rules and procedures may result in eviction or removal from the Park.

T I C K E T E D S C H O O L I N G

Ticketed schooling will open at 8am on Thursday in both the Round (Novice & Jumper ring) arena and the Grandstand (Hunter) arena. Schooling will close in the Grandstand arena at 1pm in preparation for the afternoon Clinic.

Schooling on show days will open at 6.30am in both arenas and will close at 7.30am in the Grandstand arena and 8.00am in the Round arena.

A warm up area will be available at all other times.

A number must be worn at all times when mounted.

If there is a tie in any of the classes, a count back will take place with an emphasis on course riding, control and riding position.

- 1051 Rider Over Obstacles — Under 18 yrs. Over fences up to 2'6"
- 1052 Rider Over Obstacles — 18+ yrs. Over fences up to 2'9"
