CLASS/DIVISION DESCRIPTIONS:

AHJA Members may have additional cross-entry restrictions. Refer to the 2020-2021 AHJA Rule Book for specifications on AHJA Medal classes.

Ticketed Schooling is available for both Hunter and Jumper rings for \$25/day.

Warmup Classes are unjudged.

Leadline/Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 10 years and younger, as of Dec 1, 2020. Riders may be accompanied in the ring by adults with or without a lead. Note: May cross-enter in Walk Trot divisions.

NEW - Introduction to Course Riding: 6 - 8 obstacles starting with poles and progressing to 18". To be ridden with hunter circle and courtesy circle as a hunter course. Class to remain open for duration of the day - to be used as a warm up prior to each division. Riders may be accompanied in the ring with or without a lead.

Walk Trot: Open to beginner riders. Riders may not cross-enter into any other classes except Pleasure W/T, GAYP and individual canter. Riders must choose to trot in GAYP. (AHJA members are subject to AHJA rules.) May cross-enter in Walk Trot divisions.

Pleasure: Open to any horse or rider (English and Western). To be judged on manners, obedience and way of going. In the Go As You Please phase, riders must choose the same gait in both directions.

Mini Crossrail Equitation: Fences 9"; Open to novice riders. Trotting not penalized. Riders may not cross-enter into any classes with fences higher than 12".

Crossrail: Fences 12"; Riders may not cross enter into any classes with fences higher than 18". Trotting allowed.

Future Hunter/Rider: Fences 18"; riders may not cross-enter into any classes with fences higher than 2'. No oxers.

Mini, Youth, & Silver Stirrup

Mini Stirrup: 11 y/o & under; Young: ages 12-17; Silver: 18 & over. Fences 2'; riders may not cross-enter into any classes higher than 2'3". No oxers. All three divisions may be combined for points.

Pre-Children's/Adult: Fences 2'3"; riders may not cross-enter into any classes with fences higher than 2'6".

Children's/Adult: Fences 2'6"; riders may not cross-enter into any classes with fences higher than 2'9".

Junior/Adult: Fences 2'9". No cross-entry restrictions.

I N F O & P R I Z E S

Show management reserves the right to refuse any entries at its sole discretion.

Show management may combine classes/divisions, or delete classes in the interest of time.

Attire & Equipment: Riding boots with a heel and an ASTM-approved riding helmet are mandatory for riders. USEF rules will be followed for horse equipment. Exception: wraps or boots are allowed. Martingales are prohibited in non-jumping and hunter hack classes.

Riders may share a horse in the same Hunter/Eq classes. Each horse/rider combo has a separate number. Points follow the number.

Professionals may be judged in an Open or Schooling classes and all Jumper classes, or in any other classes NTBJ.

All horses must display a show number when ridden on show grounds. No exceptions.

CSHS Awards & Prizes: Ribbons awarded 1st - 6th place. Championship and Reserve Championship ribbons are awarded for each division. Additional prizes awarded for 1st Place and Championships.

For **Championships** to be awarded, there must be a minimum of 3 entries per class, and exhibitor must have entered in all classes in the division. Each CSHS Hunter and/or Equitation division is 3 or 5 classes.

Jumper division Championships & Reserve Championships to be awarded.

CSHS Year-End Hi-Point Awards (Jan-Nov 2021): Must have shown in same division at least 3 times & been Champion at least once to be eligible. Awards will be presented at Dec 2021 show.

Pens: Limited quantity. Reservations must be made in advance through Chris Davey @ 917.238.0548 or chris@copperstatehorseshow.com, not through John Volken Academy Ranch.

R E G I S T R A T I O N & F E E S

Registration: We ask that you enter on horseshowing.com by the pre-entry date. You may also enter on copperstatehorseshow.com; this is a more manual process. Once you complete your entry, print it along with the waiver and mail it with your check for deposit/office fees to 6801 E. Mescal St., Scottsdale, AZ 85254. You may also call to provide a credit card or Venmo payment for your deposit/office fees by phone. Contact Kimberly Davey @ 602.722.0149. A 3% convenience fee applies to all credit card and Venmo payments.

Check In: A signed, blank check or credit card details must be left with your entry form when you pick up your number(s) at the show.

Check Out: When you check out, you may either fill out your check or pay by cash, Venmo or credit card. If you do not close out with show office, your original payment method will be used.

Payment Methods: M/C, Visa, AMEX, Venmo (3.0% convenience fee), Cash or Check. Returned check fee is \$50.00.
