**Introducing, the first official release of the all original album by Tom Carlile:
Music City Blues**

Tom entered the Nashville music scene in 1981 with a large collection of newly written original songs to fill an album and more. After securing a record deal with a local independent label Tom recorded these songs and released the "Feel" album as well as several hit singles that made quite an impact on the Country music scene. Following up several top 40 singles Tom went on a cross country tour promoting his music and the chart success he enjoyed. The next step in this journey was to secure a major record label contract and seek membership into the very exclusive club of "Country Stars" of the time. This goal became very difficult due to the politics and dealings in the music industry that few ever see. Disappointed at not being able to find an entrance into this elusive collection of artists Tom continued his career and his song writing. Hoping that adding to his ever growing original song catalog would eventually find its way into opening the right doors. Having now seen the "business of the music industry" first hand and seeing similar stories play out in many ways for other talented artists Tom wrote a song about what he had encountered and loosely paralleling his own experiences. The story was so intriguing Tom even wrote his autobiography years later using the same title. These stories of the Music City Blues represents those observations and journey that so many have taken.
