

REGULAR LOCAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION

Pursuant to the Regular Local Election Act, NMSA 1978, Sections 1-22-2 to 1-22-19 (1969, as amended through 2019), I, Tanya Shelby, San Juan County Clerk, of the State of New Mexico, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby issue the following:

That a Regular Local Election is hereby called to be held throughout the County of San Juan, State of New Mexico, and in each precinct thereof, on the 5th day of November 2019; and

That a Regular Local Election shall be a nonpartisan election, and the names of all candidates shall be listed on the ballot with no party or slate designation; and

That a Regular Local Election shall be applicable to the following local governments: Aztec Municipal School District, Bloomfield Municipal School District, Central Consolidated School District, Farmington Municipal School District, San Juan College, San Juan Soil and Water Conservancy District and Valley Water and Sanitation District.

That the Regular Local Election shall be for the purpose of permitting qualified electors to nominate candidates for the following offices:

Declarations of intent to be a write-in candidate for all elective local government offices shall be filed with the respective county clerk on Tuesday, September 3, 2019, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

ABSENTEE VOTING will be conducted at the San Juan County Clerk's Office, 100 South Oliver Drive, Suite 200, Aztec, New Mexico, commencing on Tuesday, October 8, 2019 and ending on Saturday, November 2, 2019. The last day to mail an absentee ballot is Friday, November 1, 2019.

EARLY/IN PERSON VOTING will be conducted at the County Clerk's Office, commencing on Tuesday, October 8, 2019 during regular business hours, 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Beginning Saturday, October 19, 2019, voting hours at the county clerk's office will be 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday and Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. The last day for all In Person/Early Voting will be Saturday, November 2, 2019 at 6:00 p.m.
