ORDER EXTENDING TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

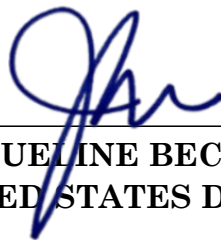
THIS CAUSE comes before the court on Plaintiff’s Second Motion to Extend Temporary Restraining Order, (the “Motion”) filed by Plaintiff, Kitsch LLC (“Plaintiff”). ECF No. [25]. In the Motion, Plaintiff requests that the Sealed Temporary Restraining Order, dated September 12, 2025, ECF No. [15], be extended to avoid prejudicing Defendants’ right to appear and respond in a timely fashion.

As of the filing of the Motion, Defendants had not yet been served because Plaintiff did not have sufficient time between receiving a copy of the Sealed Order Authorizing Alternative Service and the expiration of the TRO. *See* ECF Nos. [23]; [25]. Under the Rule 65(b)(2) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Court may extend a temporary restraining order upon a finding of good cause or if “the adverse party consents to a longer extension.” Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(b)(2). Good cause exists

pursuant to Local Rule 7.6 to continue the Hearing to afford counsel the right to appear and respond in a timely fashion. See, e.g., *Leading Edge Mktg. v. P'ship & Unincorporated Ass'n Identified on Schedule "A"*, No. 21cv-23480-KMW, 2021 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 259365, at *1 (S.D. Fla. Nov. 18, 2021); *Chanel, Inc. v. HandbagStore*, No. 20-CIV-62121-RAR, 2020 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 248563, at *3 (S.D. Fla. Nov. 24, 2020).

Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the Motion, ECF No. [25], is **GRANTED**. The Temporary Restraining Order ("TRO") entered by this Court on September 12, 2025, ECF No. [15] is hereby extended and shall remain in effect for fourteen (14) additional calendar days up to and including December 3, 2025. All terms and conditions of the TRO remain in full force and effect for the time hereby extended.
