



What is TAG DAY?

TAG DAY is the Revere High School Music Program's largest fundraising event of the year. Tag day is held every year on the second Saturday in August. This year Tag Day will take place on **AUGUST 9 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.**

- All students who are in RHS music: band, color guard, choir, and orchestra are strongly encouraged to participate including incoming freshmen.
- Money is raised through door-to-door fundraising by asking neighbors for their monetary support and leaving them with a schedule (Tag) of 5th through 12th grade music performances.
- While a portion of the RHS Music Program is funded by the school budget, we need outside funds to help with uniforms, equipment needs, fees, and supplies to name a few as well as scholarships.

What you need to know right now?

- Students will register in teams of two. Student sign ups will occur in during band camp. Choir and orchestra students created teams prior to the end of the school year. Teams should consist of a first year student and a partner who has already participated in Tag Day. If you, the student, have not signed up for a team, you can show up the morning of the event to be assigned to a team.
- Each team must have a parent driver. We encourage freshmen/1st year parents to be drivers as this is a great opportunity to get to know our music program students and other parents! Parents will receive an email the first week of August for route sign ups and other volunteer opportunities for that day via SignUp Genius.
