- Several students have had the opportunity to participate in Honors Bands at Kent State, University of Akron and Ohio State.
- Three RMS students will be participating in the District Honors Band on February 22.
- Upcoming concerts include:
 - March 5- 7th and 8th grade band
 - March 6- High School band featuring Copley and Barberton bands and guest conductor, Jeff King. Band Council will be hosting a reception following the concert and will need donations from families.
 - o March 11- 5th and 6th grade band

- March 14- OMEA Large Group Contest. The band will need some adult volunteers to help with registration and crowd management in the cafeteria. Volunteers will be provided dinner.
