Band and Choir Council Presidents Report - Cassie Keaton

Director's Report - Band, Choir, Orchestra

- New band and color guard uniforms are on order and will be delivered by the end of the year.
- 29 students have expressed interest in color guard for next year.
- All music groups have Winter concerts scheduled for late February- early March.
- OMEA events will occur in March. Revere is hosting an OMEA adjudicated event for bands on 3/10.

President's Report - Dave Balnave

- RMPA recruitment- Dave discussed critical need to invite music parents to participate in RMPA and replace many roles on the executive board and committee chairs.
 Representatives from RMPA will be speaking at the upcoming concerts to share information about RMPA and invite parents to volunteer/support the music programs.
- Members noted that the Orchestra and Choir are doing fundraising this year. RMPA board clarified that the fundraising efforts go to RMPA to help cover expenses. QR codes in the concert programs direct potential donors to RMPA. Parent members discussed the perception that the Winter Concert program offered patron, shout out, and ad space to benefit the Choral programs. There was some confusion about whether these donation benefit only choir or the RMPA as a whole. The other concern was that the sponsorship opportunity wasn't available to all music parents.
- Attendees discussed that RMPA recruiting should begin earlier like the elementary/middle school. RMPA could attend the 5th grade music instrument introduction session. RMPA could also assist with events at the middle school. This would create the opportunity to connect the middle school and high school students and improve retention as the students transition to the high school music programs.
- Other ideas/suggestions include hosting an event/cook out following the Memorial Day parade. RMPA could host a table at Froshfest.
- Marianne Grandon offered to connect with prior RMPA leadership to see what recruiting materials are available and could be leveraged.
