CMR's are needed to act as the company representative as a Permit Holder and for supervising the contractor for the construction of the project "SVL T3 Transformer Refurbishment"

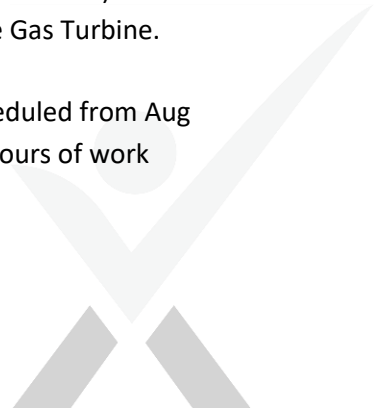
The contractor scope includes but not limited to:

- Mobilization and demobilization to Stephenville Terminal Station
- Drain and dispose oil
- Hot oil flush
- Internal inspection
- Bushing replacement (HV, LV, H0)
- Bushing draw lead modifications
- Radiator replacement (Qty: 13)
- Leak repair
- Install Hydran
- Painting
- Supply of oil
- Vacuum oil filling
- Oil testing
- Commissioning

CMR scope includes but are not limited to: Construction supervision and provision of technical oversight for all aspects of Contractor's work; participation in tailboards, progress meetings and safety meetings with Contractor and Owner; delivering orientations and training to Contractor's personnel and site visitors; providing daily updates to Contract Manager and documenting construction through photographs and completion of Inspector's daily reports; Completing material transfer forms and all other documentation related to Owner's ESOP's; ensuring Contractor's compliance with HSE plans, JHA's, Covid-19 plan and Work Methods; Review of and assisting Contractor with completion of commissioning binders for new equipment; and Completion of as-built drawings. The CMR must also act as the WPC Permit Holder during outages.

Project Location Directions: From Sir Thomas Roddick Hospital in Stephenville, travel NE on Minnesota Drive to Route 490. Turn right on Hwy 490 and travel 3.8 km turn right onto (old Abitibi Mill Road) travel 1 km and turn right travel 0.5km and turn right and follow road for 0.5km to Stephenville Gas Turbine.

Anticipated Schedule: Two CMRs will be required to cover this scope of work that is scheduled from Aug 5th to Aug 23rd (Actual dates may be changed based on contractor mobilization date). Hours of work subject to Contractor's proposed schedule.





One CMR will work day shift and other will work night shift.

A day shift CMR will be required for the duration Aug 5th – 23rd

A night shift CMR will be required for the duration Aug 16th -22nd
