

Connex Personnel is currently recruiting for a Marine Operations Lead (MOL) on a 6-month contract with an upcoming oil and gas project. This role will start mid-March 2023.

This position is essential for face-to-face transmission of requirements related to safety, stop-the-job reinforcement and company guideline mentoring. The MOL is active and close to the frontline with vessel port call visits and vessel operational rides. They also provide support for Logistics Management System (LMS) evidence uploads and audit tracking, which is supported by the above region Marine Technical Advisor (MTA). The above region resource provides other technical support to compliment the operational regional MOL.

Successful candidate will lead regional marine activities for 2.5 months prior to commencement of drilling operations.

- Attends daily planning meetings with project team, superintendents & engineering team
- Conducts physical oversight activities across the marine discipline, providing feedback to the Centre of Excellence (COE) for LMS compliance
- Understands company Marine Assurance process
- Develops relationship with above region MTA
- Inputs into region-specific Marine Operations Manual
- Interfaces with rig contractor on marine operations (within 500m zone)
- Interfaces with fluids contractor and Supply Base team on under deck cargo carrying; verifies connections from shore to vessel and vessel to rig
- Liaises with vessel contractor on vessel readiness and monitors mobilization timeline
- Prepares for arrival of marine fleet in region
- Liaises between regulator and vessel contractor
- Conducts vessel ride-along on each vessel at commencement of operations and appropriate intervals thereafter with report provided to Contract Accountable Manager (CAM)
- Monitors crew training and competence
- Conducts site visits onboard vessels at each port call
- Develops relationship with Marine Contractor management and establishes regular meeting cadence for operational team meetings to discuss safety, performance and cost; undertakes regular oversight visits to contractor offices to complete company oversight plan requirements
- Receives WELs training to enable support for vessels
- Advises Global Wells Organization (GWO) team on all regional marine operations
