

Connex Personnel is currently seeking a Construction Management Representative(s) (CMR), to act as a Permit Holder, and support the execution of project work in location(s) as outlined below.

This support is required for oversight of a construction contract for civil works, as well as some related electrical works, associated with the replacement of one (1) 69kV circuit breaker at the Hardwoods Terminal Station (HWD) and one (1) 138kV circuit breaker at the Howley Terminal Station (HLY). The Contractor scope of work encompasses all associated civil works, as well as some related electrical works, which mainly includes, but is not limited to, activities associated with those circuit breaker replacements such as the removal of existing circuit breakers; removal and/or installation of concrete foundations, grounding and conduit; preparation and/or reinstatement of subgrade and yard gravel.

As a CMR, the role involves conducting safety orientations, participating in tailboards, verifying work progress, performing quality checks and inspections, preparation of as-built drawings, preparing daily reports as well as ensuring that the Contractor is adhering to the contract documents. Also included is oversight of NL Hydro's Safety, Health and Environment plans, NL Hydro Standards as well as oversight of Contractor's quality plan.

Candidates should have good communication skills and be assertive with the Contractor as required to ensure that the Contractor is performing duties of the contractual scope in a safe, efficient and effective manner. Candidates will discuss site progress and issues with NL Hydro engineering and/or Contract Manager multiple times per day as required to efficiently resolve any issues at site relating to the work, etc. to ensure that work progress continues as efficiently as possible.

Candidates should have experience in high voltage (HV) terminal station equipment replacements, preferably involving civil and some electrical related construction.

Familiarity with NL Hydro processes and procedures for terminal station construction, particularly in relation to circuit breaker replacements, as well as QA/QC experience is also an asset.

Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro follow all provincial health and safety guidelines as well as additional guidelines set out by our own NL Hydro Safety and Health department. The candidate will adhere to all NL Hydro's safety requirements.

WorkplaceNL certified Powerline Hazards Training, Standard First Aid Training, Fall Protection Training and WHMIS 2015 with GHS are also required as well as other NL Hydro specific training such as, but not limited to, NL Hydro CMR Training, Defensive Driving Training, Work Protection Code Training, Working Near Energized Lines & Equipment Training, etc. As the CMR is also required to be Permit Holder in all cases, the individual must be, or eligible to be, work protection code qualified by NL Hydro, which also includes having the required relevant NL Hydro experience, in addition to the required training/certification/authorization, in relation to the permit holding function.
