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Dixie Lee Farmers' Market Rules and Regulations
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## Rules and Regulations

**All applicants must submit an application, along with applicable certificates, two weeks (14 days) before the date they expect to begin selling. No exceptions.**

### Rules and Regulations

1. A Member of the Dixie Lee Farmers' Market or their representative must sell all products.
2. Members can not re-sell any products. Member must create the products sold at the market.
3. These products must have been created on member's own property, or on land leased or rented by the Member.
4. Only top quality products will be permitted to be sold at the Dixie Lee Farmers' Market.
5. No co-ops, corporate owned farms, or partnerships, etc. are allowed to sell at the market. Only individuals may apply for active membership. Exceptions may be made for churches, schools or other community based projects.
6. Because the Pick Tennessee logo is featured, all products should come from Tennessee, which is defined by all Tennessee counties.  
On rare occasions, the Managers may accept applications for products created outside the Tennessee area (for example, Western North Carolina, Southern Kentucky or Western Virginia).
7. With the paid annual membership fee. Each member is allowed a maximum of two parking spaces for one vehicle and one set up space per membership. If additional vehicle space is required, an additional parking fee may be assessed.
8. The Town of Farragut requires that you NOT SELL FROM BACK OF TRUCKS. Therefore you must have a table to set up and sell your products. Dixie Lee Farmers Market does not furnish any tents, tables, chairs, etc. You must come prepared.
9. It is the responsibility of Members to adhere to all revenue requirements, rules and regulations, both on the state and federal level. Any sales tax collection is the responsibility of the Member. It is also the responsibility of the vendor to pay appropriate sales tax to the Tennessee Department of Revenue.
10. No early sales will be permitted. Sales can begin ONLY AFTER 9am. Please be fair and considerate. The Market hours are Saturdays from 9 a.m. till noon. Setup may begin at 8 a.m. on the day of the Market.
11. To assure your regular spot, Venders must be at their site setting up by 8:30am.

12. Items should be clearly marked.
13. Prices must be fair and similar to like products of other vendors.
14. At market close, members are responsible for cleaning up the immediate area around one's space. Failure to comply may result in a fine or exclusion from the Market.
15. No vendors may have their pets with them at market.
16. Members understand that inclement weather may exist.

#### **FEES**

The fees that are charged are based the average or expected monies spent in the managing, advertising and operating cost.

All applicants must submit an application for new membership, along with applicable certificates, \*two weeks (14 days) before the date they expect to begin selling.

**Annual Membership Fee:** \$20.00, due before your first set up at the Market;

**Weekly set up fee:** \$15.00 collected day of market or paid in advanced.
