- Size (w x h) inches (over 36"x 36" and 10 pounds need curatorial approval)
- o Medium
- o Price or NFS
- o Purchase Method: QR Code, Cash, Check (if applicable)
- Your Contact Information for interested buyers/patrons.
- o A jpg image of your artwork(s) for website and media releases

RAA RULES OF ENTRY:

• Open to artists who are current members of the Ridgefield Art Association.

•Acceptance of artwork is at the curators' discretion (limited wall space, size, weight, not "family friendly", etc.)

• Artwork jpg images will be used for the RAA website, social media and publicity releases.

•All entries must have "D" rings with museum wire and be ready to install/hang. Click <u>Instructions</u> for how to install "D" rings with museum wire on artworks or frames.

Artwork Sold:

• Collecting money for artwork sold is the responsibility of the artist. The buyer may take the artwork with them at the time of the sale, or the artist may arrange for the buyer to wait until the exhibition pick-up date (preferred).

- Notify Brenda at bberg007@comcast.net or any Curatorial member if:
 - \checkmark your artwork was sold
 - \checkmark the buyer must take your artwork at the time of purchase
 - \checkmark you will or if you are not able to replace the sold artwork with a comparable artwork
 - ✓ you need a replacement artwork wall ID
 - \checkmark you have any additional questions

Photographing Your Artwork

Email a jpg image of your artwork with your ENTRY information (see page 1):

- File Type: jpg only
- File Size: No larger than 5 MB
- Color Profile: RGB

There are many online resources to help you take a high-quality photograph of your artwork. HINT: Remove artwork from under any reflective surface (like glass) before photographing it. This is one site that offers some good strategies: <u>click here</u>
