**B) Emergency Management Position- Discussion & Action:**

**C) Bandstand Roof- Discussion & Action:**

There was a previous offer from a local contractor to replace the roofing and the Town would just pay for materials. Raymond will look into this to find out if that offer still stands.

**D) DPW Report:**

Norman reported that the crew has been busy with spring repairs on both the roads and equipment. There was much discussion on some of the spots on West Hill that need attention. Norman reported to the Selectboard that Doxy Roof would be coming to look at the E-Barn roof. A discussion was started on the possibility of the road crew going onto a 4, 10 hour per day week schedule for summer. Raymond told him to prepare a proposal. Norman was asked how we stand for summer paving. He is waiting for the State to get back to him with numbers before it is sent out to bid. Norman was asked to look into grants to replace the culvert on Tunnel Street for next summer.

**E) Delinquent Tax Collector- Request for use of Town Attorney for Bankruptcy issues- Discussion & Action:**

Ted stated that he had received a notice from Bankruptcy Court in regard to Lending Institute that has declared bankruptcy. He is requesting to speak to the Towns attorney for clarification on what this means for the Town. He also would like to find out if there are differences between an individual declaring bankruptcy as opposed to a lending institute. Raymond gave him permission to speak with our attorney Bob Fisher to ask his questions.

Raymond would like to move ahead with some sort of system. Karen will look into a few different companies after she speaks with the school as well as a few surrounding Towns.
