Miami, Florida- February 11, 2019- Assembly of the Cuban Resistance. “All for a Free Cuba.” We announce the beginning of a series of actions, organized by exiled Cuban, Venezuelan, and Nicaraguan leaders and activists leading up to the event at Miami City Hall to denounce the electoral farce of the Castro regime on February 24, 2019, and request to the Trump Administration the full implementation of Title III of the Helms-Burton Act.

The Assembly of the Cuban Resistance will hold a press conference to announce the important Congress, alongside the Venezuelan and Nicaraguan Diasporas.

The Cuban exiled community will announce a series of steps to support the efforts of the Resistance inside Cuba to boycott the electoral farce on February 24 and to express their rejection of the illegitimate regime that has held power in Cuba for 60 years.

To this end, the Congress of the Assembly of the Cuban Resistance for the National Unity will take place on February 24, 2019.

During the Congress at Miami City Hall from 9 am to 12 noon, there will be specific support for the prosecution of Raul Castro and other members of the regime for crimes against humanity perpetrated against Cubans, Nicaraguans, and Venezuelans. As well, the Assembly will request the full implementation of Title III of the Helms-Burton Act to allow victims of the regime's confiscation and trafficking in stolen properties to seek justice at the appropriate courts.
