A Reflection on Sunday's Word

Putting Our Faith into Action Through Perseverance

We are never alone in our trials, even when the path ahead feels incredibly heavy and the night seems long. In times of deep tribulation, it is comforting to remember that God uniquely shapes and uses those who choose to persevere rather than pull away. Throughout scripture, we see that the people God used mightily were not those who lived easy lives, but those who refused to quit when things got tough. Great biblical heroes faced overwhelming burdens and, at times, desperately wanted to give up. Noah spent decades building an ark amidst total mockery; Moses carried the weight of a stubborn nation even when he felt inadequate; and Paul faced relentless persecution yet never stopped preaching the gospel.

Their endurance reminds us that our current struggles are not a sign of God's absence, but rather a training ground for spiritual maturity. True faith is the absolute assurance of things hoped for, even when the evidence around us remains completely unseen. When our circumstances stubbornly refuse to change despite our prayers, God invites us to shift our perspective away from our discomfort. Instead of asking Him why this is happening, we can ask a deeper question: "Lord, what do you want from me in this season?"

You are not the only one passing through difficult tribulations right now, and your pain is not pointless. While God may not always give us the immediate relief or outcomes we want, He faithfully provides the exact grace and strength we need to build our character, anchor our hope, and endure. Let us walk by faith and not by sight this week, trusting that He is at work in the waiting.
