A Reflection on Sunday's Word

Faith That Reaches Jesus

The story of the woman who had been suffering for twelve years reminds us of the power of faith and reaching out to Jesus. She had tried everything and continued to suffer, but when she heard about Jesus, she believed that even touching His clothing could bring healing. Her faith moved her to reach out, and Jesus recognized her faith and responded with compassion.

The lesson also reminds us that sometimes people can become so familiar with Jesus that they fail to recognize who He truly is. When Jesus returned to His hometown, many people questioned His wisdom and power because they knew Him as someone familiar to them. Their lack of faith affected what they were able to experience.

Our faith matters. We are encouraged to come to Jesus with confidence, trust Him even when circumstances seem impossible, and recognize that God's power may not always look the way the world expects. What may seem foolish to the world can be the very power of God at work in our lives.

This week, ask yourself: Am I willing to reach out to Jesus in faith, even when I don't know what He will do?
