A Reflection on Sunday's Word Trust the Process

Life moves through different seasons, and every season has a purpose. In Mark 4, Jesus compares the Kingdom of God to a seed planted in the ground. The farmer plants, waits, and trusts, even though he cannot see what is happening beneath the soil.

Our faith can be the same way. We often want immediate answers, growth, healing, and breakthroughs, but God's work often happens quietly and gradually.

We may not see it, measure it, or speed it up, but God is still working.

The seed must be planted, roots must grow, and eventually the harvest will come. Our responsibility is to receive God's Word, believe it, obey it, and remain faithful while trusting God with the process.

When you cannot see God's hand, trust His process. The seed is still alive. The roots are still growing. God is still working. And when the time is right, the harvest will come.

Keep praying. Keep serving. Keep believing. Keep planting. Trust the Process.
