## A Reflection on Sunday's Word

The message centered on the idea that you were created for a specific purpose in this exact moment in time,

“for such a time as this” (Esther 4:14).

It emphasized that your life is not accidental; God intentionally placed you where you are to respond with faith, courage, and purpose, especially in uncertain or challenging times.

Using Esther's story, the message highlighted that even ordinary people, like a young orphan who became queen, can be used by God in powerful ways when they are willing to step forward in obedience and courage. Esther didn't choose her circumstances, but she chose to act when it mattered most, trusting God even when His presence wasn't obvious.

The key reminders were:

- You are not late, overlooked, or unprepared
- God has already equipped you for this season
- His timing and placement in your life are intentional
- Even when God seems silent, He is still working behind the scenes

Ultimately, the message encouraged believers to trust God fully, stand firm in faith, and be willing to act boldly, knowing that God can use their lives to bring hope, truth, and change in the world around them.

- Write a short prayer asking God for courage, wisdom, and trust.
