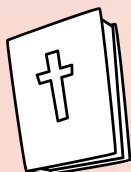

A Reflection on Sunday's Word

Remember that obedience is not simply about following rules, but about living with a heart that trusts God and respects the guidance He places in our lives. The message emphasized that true obedience brings blessing, direction, and spiritual growth, while also strengthening our relationships with others.

Honoring parents and recognizing the sacrifices they make for their children. Mothers, in particular, were celebrated for the countless ways they teach, encourage, and prepare their families for life. Through everyday moments and lifelong lessons, mothers help shape character, build wisdom, and instill values that remain with us for years to come.

The message reflected on many of the lessons mothers pass down to their children—teaching them how to pray, think wisely, use good judgment, share with others, stay motivated, and prepare for the future. 
