A Reflection on Sunday's Word

Walking in the Protection of God

This week's message reminded us of the incredible protection God provides for His people, often in ways we cannot see or even imagine. Through the story of King Hezekiah and the nation of Judah, we were encouraged to bring our problems to God first, trusting Him to fight battles that are beyond our ability to overcome. When Judah faced an overwhelming enemy force, Hezekiah sought the Lord in prayer, and God responded with power and deliverance.

The message also highlighted that God's protection is closely connected to having a healthy fear of the Lord—not a fear of punishment, but a deep sense of awe, reverence, and respect for His holiness and power. When we honor God and place our trust in Him, we can live with confidence, knowing that He watches over us and surrounds us with His care.

As believers, we are encouraged to seek God's wisdom, trust His guidance, and remember that He is always working on our behalf. No matter what challenges we face, we can find peace in knowing that our lives are in His hands. The service concluded with Holy Communion, reminding us of Christ's sacrifice and the new covenant established through His body and blood, a lasting demonstration of God's love, protection, and faithfulness to His people.
