## A Reflection on Sunday's Word Learning to Rely on God

This week's message centered on the powerful truth. We are called to stop relying on ourselves and instead learn to rely fully on God.

Drawing from 2 Corinthians 1:9, the message reminded us that life's challenges often push us to the point where self-reliance is no longer enough, by design. In those moments, we are invited to place our trust in the One who has power over all things.

Throughout Scripture, we see a consistent call to trust God wholeheartedly. Whether in seasons of fear, uncertainty, or surrender, we are reminded that true peace and joy come from placing our confidence in Him rather than in our own strength, resources, or understanding.

The message also reflected on personal and church journeys, highlighting that trust in God is not automatic, but something that is developed over time. Like the enduring legacy of faithful believers who have overcome hardship and remained steadfast, we too are shaped through life's pressures to depend more deeply on God.

Many of us begin by relying on what feels secure, our experience, finances, relationships, or abilities. However, when those supports fall short, God uses those moments to reveal where our trust truly lies and to draw us closer to Him.

The takeaway is both simple and challenging: trust must be learned. As we surrender control and release false confidence, God grows our faith and teaches us to rely fully on Him. Our prayer is that we would continue to trust Him more deeply each day, allowing His strength to guide our journey.

## Journaling Activity

This week's message challenged us to examine where our trust truly lies. Often, we rely on our own strength, plans, or resources, but God invites us into a deeper, more meaningful dependence on Him.

Take a few quiet moments this week to reflect and journal through the prompts below:

1. Where am I currently relying on myself more than God?

Think about areas of stress, decision-making, or uncertainty. What are you holding tightly that may need to be surrendered?

2. What situations in my life have pushed me to depend on God more?

Reflect on past challenges. How did those moments shape your faith or perspective?

3. What does it look like for me to "trust God with my whole heart"?

Consider how trust shows up in your daily life, your thoughts, actions, and choices.

4. What fears do I need to release to God?

Be honest about what worries or overwhelms you. Write a prayer giving those fears to Him.

5. What is one practical step I can take this week to rely more on God?

This could be through prayer, letting go of control in a situation, or choosing faith over fear.
