Take 10 to 15 minutes this week to find a quiet space. Slow down your breathing, quiet your mind, and answer these prompts honestly.

1. Checking Your Fuel Tank: We often try to face our daily trials using our own limited strength, which leads to burnout.

On a scale of 1 to 10, how spiritually and emotionally exhausted do you feel right now?

In what specific area of your life (work, family, health, or habits) have you been trying to "muscle through" using only your own energy?

2. Cultivating Alignment: The early believers experienced a powerful state of spiritual harmony, shared purpose, and unified thinking.

Are there any broken relationships, unspoken resentments, or disagreements in your life right now that are disrupting your peace?

What is one practical step you can take this week to bring unity, forgiveness, or harmony into your home or your church community?

3. Surrendering the Weight: True freedom and lasting healing are found when we yield our struggles, breaking the chains of worry, depression, or past hurts.

What heavy weight are you carrying today? Name the specific anxiety, past hurt, or fear that is currently stealing your joy.

Write a short statement of surrender, consciously handing that burden over to God and asking for supernatural peace to replace it.

4. Moving Forward in Boldness: Divine guidance empowers us to step into a life of supernatural boldness and confidence.

If you were operating with absolute confidence instead of fear, what is one bold step you would take this week?

How can you actively invite a fresh filling of hope and joy into your morning routine tomorrow?
