Preliminary Requirements

Before an application for admission to Lighthouse College can be processed, there are certain requirements that prospective students must take into consideration. We encourage all high school seniors to start early, to gather this information. The essential requirements are listed below:

- 1. All prospective students must have a High School Diploma from a recognized school. Whether the student went to a public, private, or charter school, a diploma is essential to the process. Even home-educated students can usually receive a recognized diploma. If for some reason it is not possible, an alternative GED credential is acceptable.
- 2. A copy of official High School transcripts will be required at the time of application also. If these are unavailable, a copy of all high school courses and corresponding grades received in these courses, will be acceptable if they come from an educational authority.
- 3. A sufficient score on a standardized aptitude test such as the SAT or the ACT will also be required before an application can be considered. Most graduating high school seniors have multiple options for taking one of these exams, and most communities offer this test to the general public at various times and places.

While the above three items are the important and needed prerequisites, the following items do carry some weight in the education process, and a prospective student may wish to consider adding these items to their profile as well. They would include:

- Substantive High School Research If a high school student has given significant time and energy to produce a special and substantive work that reflects well upon that persons educational capacity, it may be worth including.
- Vocational or Technical Training Many high school students have the opportunity to engage in specialized technical or trade school programs that may reflect well on a candidates' application.
- Varsity Letters or Academic Honors While not required, often this extra work at the high school level can enhance an application for admission.
- Documented Community Service Those students who give of themselves to help their community and who can document those efforts properly, can include that work in their submission for consideration
- Christian Service Those high school students who give consistent time for ministry in their church, on mission trips, in various other ministry opportunities, can certainly add that to their application for admission, if it would give a better understanding of the heart of that person.

While there may be more items that could be considered here, these should be sufficient to give an understanding of what may be helpful. Remember, the first three items at the top of the page are mandatory, while the others are only suggestions.

Specific Program Request

Lighthouse College is offering two different programs of study for the 2026-2027 school year. Each program has specific capacity enrollments for their program (thirty-six [36] students in Medical Assisting and sixty [60)] in General Studies), before it is deemed "closed" or "full." When this occurs, a potential student can switch to a secondary discipline that still has room available, or they can be put on a wait list for their original program. If the student switches, and then afterwards find that room has become available in the original program, that student will get priority for the open space.

Financial Information

The following financial information is included in the application packet, so that there can be no misunderstanding in regard to student financial costs. Unless this page is signed stating that you are aware of our financial structure and your personal responsibility, the application for admission cannot be processed.

Individual Student Yearly Cost (Full-time student)

Once admitted, the student's cost structure below will remain the same **for the entire time of enrollment for up to four years.** If the student drops out or does not return for consecutive semesters (not including summer classes), this benefit will be forfeited. Beginning with the 2026-2027 School year:

Application for Enrollment

An application fee of \$100.00 must accompany all applications for student admission before it will be processed. If the application is accepted the entire \$100.00 will be applied to the student bill. If the application is rejected, \$50.00 will be refunded.

Please understand that a maximum of 100 students is all that will be accepted in our first year. Once that number is obtained, other prospective students can be placed on a waiting list if they would so desire.

Part-time Student Financial Information

The cost of classes for part-time students will be \$150.00 per credit hour. This means that a three-credit course will cost \$450.00, , and part-time students may only take three classes per semester. It should be noted that all part-time students must still fill out an application, be accepted into the college, and further agree to abide by all other pertinent Lighthouse College rules and regulations.

Student Tuition Refund Policy

If any student withdraws within the first two weeks of classes, a 75% refund will apply to tuition, room & board money that has been paid. The third week this amount drops to 50%, and after the third week of classes, there is no refund available.

Student Payment Process

All student payment and fees will be handled through the Admissions/Registrar's office. Payments can be made in person, through PayPal, or through a direct transfer arrangement. Also, payments can be made with cash, by check, by credit card, by direct transfer, or with a certified bank check. No change in what is owed on the student's bill will occur, until all funds clear the respective financial institutions.

Student Financial Aid

While Lighthouse College is new and small, we still have several viable student financial aid opportunities that are available to our students. They are listed below:

- There will be a limited number of partial work scholarship opportunities on campus, that will be available for our students. This will provide up to twenty hours each week of employment at the rate of @ \$12.00 an hour.
- We are building partnerships with local businesses who are enthusiastic about hiring our students at the rate of at least \$14.00 an hour. Some will be offering steady part-time work, while others will be offering full-time 2nd and 3rd shift opportunities for those who are enrolled as full-time students at Lighthouse College.
- We are able to accept secured student loans for those who need to consider this option.
