We provide healthcare organizations an intelligent rehabilitation care platform that streamlines equipment procurement, amalgamating pertinent providers and customizing search results to individual needs. This efficiency saves time, eases administrative tasks, and facilitates access to crucial equipment for patients with paralysis-related disabilities while enabling an overall healthier care journey.

Problem.

- ◆ About 30% of individuals with Spinal cord injuries are re-hospitalized one or more times during any given year post injury contributing factors are issues with equipment & supplies needed for care.
- ◆ Disjointed processes including supplier deficiencies with poor communication & accountability; Increased paperwork, non-standardized forms, inefficient technology negatively impact results.
- ◆ Mental health disorders diagnosed in 59% of adults with spinal cord injuries, compared with 31% of the general public; chronic pain was strongly contributing to these conditions.

Solution.

- ◆ We track coordination from hospital entry to patient follow-up in one place; we provide smart recommendations.
- ◆ We provide a database of insurance approved suppliers; eliminating more calls & faxes; giving more time back to staff for patient care & self-care.
- ◆ We are capturing population wellness metrics and improving patient outcomes; with digital check-ins we capture data trends of potential rising risks in post-acute care.

What we provide.

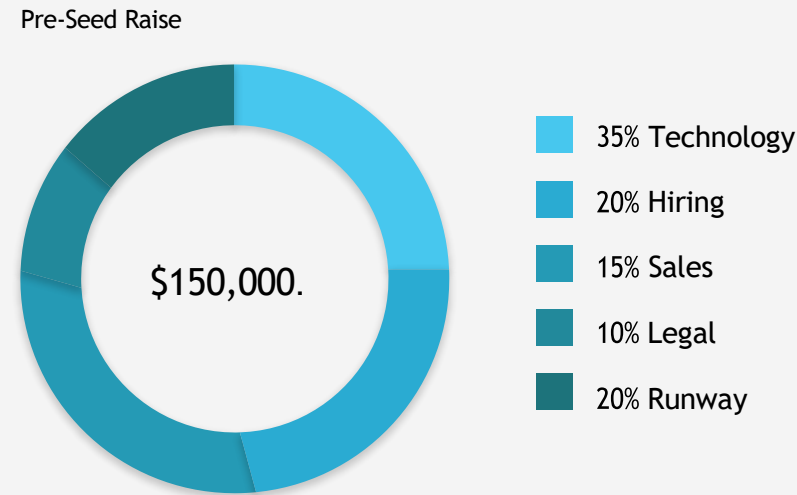
- For healthcare professionals we bring efficiency and less burden to the laborious task of equipment procurement for patients.
