Promoting Enduring Peace was founded in 1952 in the midst of the Cold War when many thought nuclear war was inevitable. PEP has conducted peace education spanning decades, brought people overseas for citizen diplomacy, published original works and has recognized distinguished peace-makers by giving out the Gandhi Peace Award. Winners have included Eleanor Roosevelt, Daniel Ellsberg, Medea Benjamin, Bill McKibben Amy Goodman, Omar Barghouti, Ralph Nader and many others.

The Growing Peril

The Cold War was a terrifying time, but the dangers today are in some ways worse. The danger of nuclear war is growing again as the U.S. “modernizes” its weapons. Greenhouse gases are sending the climate onto a catastrophic path. So many species are dying off that scientists are calling this time the “Sixth Extinction”. Racists, demagogues and strong-men are on the rise. The mission of PEP remains vital.
