Defense of Ukraine Involves More Than Weapons

There are many who oppose helping Ukraine. They say the world is walking towards nuclear war. They worry that the war is ruining critical efforts to stop burning fossil fuels. They complain that it's hypocritical for the "West" to help Ukraine while it intervenes all over the world and supports invasions and occupations in Palestine, in Yemen, and Iraq and elsewhere.

These concerns can't just be dismissed. Millions of people hold these views.

Supporters of Ukraine should call for immediate withdrawal of all Russian troops, but we think **also** should work on these campaigns:

Nuclear

The danger of nuclear war is real, but that doesn't mean countries should just fold in the face of Russian threats. Work to lessen the threat of nuclear war through support of ideas developed by the coalition "Defuse Nuclear War" Take nuclear weapons off "hair trigger" alerts, declare "no-first-use" of nuclear weapons, rejoin nuclear treaties with Russia; get rid of the ICBM's. And we say stop the imports of Russian uranium.

Fossil Fuel
